*A unique village shop featuring antique and vintage furniture, curiosities, handmade soaps and botanicals, one-of-a-kind jewelry and more.*

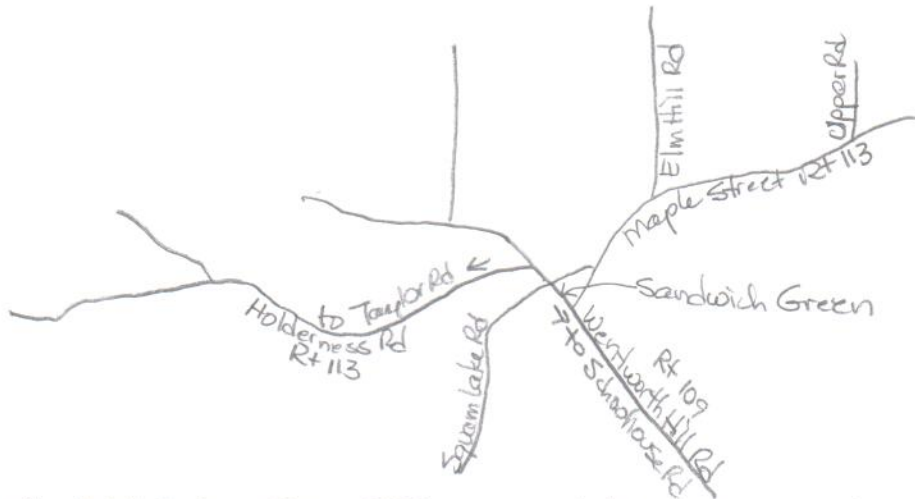
